The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field.

Our readings weave around themes of wisdom, treasure and joy. When asked in a dream what he desires from God, Solomon chooses 'a heart to understand how to discern between good and evil.' God is pleased Solomon does not seek riches or a long life, so gives him the gift of wisdom. Psalm 118 asks the Lord for his consoling love. God's law means more to the Psalmist than precious metals. Paul explains the plan now unfolding has been there from the beginning. God chose and called us all to become 'true images of his Son'. God wants all who love him and follow his teaching to share in his glory. Jesus offers three images for God's kingdom; a treasure we find unexpectedly, a pearl for which we search diligently and a net gathering us in. They illustrate the priceless value and importance of the kingdom to which all are invited. Jesus also reminds us to hold on to treasures both old and new as we seek God's kingdom. Pondering God's gift of wisdom, we pray it will guide us to the treasure, the delight of knowing and loving Jesus and the riches this brings. We ask God's help to share this with all those we encounter. *Fr Jimmy*

THE TABERNACLE

After fifty years of being prominently placed in our Church, the Tabernacle has been taken away to be repaired, cleaned and refurbished. This work will take some six weeks and cost in the region of £900. Meanwhile, the same company have loaned us a Tabernacle. We are also refurbishing the Big Six, the candles standing each side of the tabernacle. This work will cost roughly the same amount, £900. VAT and delivery will effect the final total.

We are in the process of upgrading our Loop System. A temporary unit is in place so hearing-aid users can change setting on their device and hear more clearly. Other improvements to the sound system will also be carried out, probably in the Autumn.
