The generous love of the Lord is very close to us. Our scriptures remind us when we seek the Lord, we can be confident of receiving a warm, forgiving welcome, no matter who we are. The Prophet Isaiah invites us to seek and find the Lord who is near to us. When we do, God will embrace us with rich forgiveness. Psalm 144 is a song of blessing, wonder and awe, in praise of the Lord who is close to us, full of compassion, abounding in love and kindness. In his Letter to the Philippians, Paul is confident of the closeness of Christ, even as he writes from prison. We too, are encouraged to focus our lives on the values of Christ in the Gospel. The parable of the workers in the vineyard is a Gospel for latecomers, presenting an encouraging if challenging image of God's generosity. We're invited to consider and accept this generosity for ourselves and express it towards others, even when it is challenging. If Jesus' parable teaching presents a wisdom too hard to comprehend, we might take to heart his ways are very different from ours. Scripture reassures us we need not worry, the Lord is near, ever present to us. Our God is full of compassion and forgiveness willing us to seek him. We pray the Christian community may be inspired to seek the Lord so the body of Christ can transform the world with the justice and generosity of God.
