Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

Christ, the power and the wisdom of God

Our Lenten readings remind us of God's love soon to be witnessed in the suffering and death of Christ Jesus and celebrated by us in Holy Week.

In the *Exodus Reading*, God speaks to the people of Israel after their release from slavery in Egypt. God's Ten Words show the people how to live freely in service of the God who has liberated them. In *Psalm 18*, we ponder the gifts God's law brings; wisdom, truth and life. *Paul reflects* on the way in which those called to follow Jesus see the crucified Christ. For those early Christians, and ourselves, this is not a sign of God's foolishness or weakness, but a demonstration to the world of God's power and wisdom.

In our *Gospel*, we see Jesus sweep away the buyers and sellers from the Temple, a place to be revered as the house of God. We're reminded it is through Christ's suffering and death salvation will come, and the power and wisdom of God will be revealed.

This week we pray for those areas of the world where places of holiness and sanctuary are debased and de-valued and for people who are prevented from worshipping openly, and from practising their faith in freedom. *Fr Jimmy*
