WE ARE CREATED IN CHRIST JESUS TO LIVE THE GOOD LIFE

On this Laetare, or Rejoice Sunday, our readings suggest many reasons for rejoicing. Chronicles describes the destruction of Jerusalem and the days of Israel's exile. But God, working through the Persian king, Cyrus, not only brings the Jewish people home to where they belong but helps them rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem. Paul says God, whose nature is Universal Love, brought us back to life with Christ Jesus through the gift of his infinite grace. Our good works, our lives, lived in all their fullness are a grateful and authentic response to all we have received from God. The Gospel tells us the death and resurrection of Christ Jesus, who was lifted up and exalted on the cross, brings salvation to all who believe in him. Christ's Passion, for all its injustice and brutality, is a glorious revelation of God's love for humanity. His Passion is the source of our healing. Jesus calls us to live by his truth, so we can dwell in God's life and love. Our Psalm of longing lament recalls the bitter days of Israel's exile in Babylon. For us, Babylon is a symbol of everything threatening the fullness of human life; selfishness, greed, and pride take us away from wholeness of life into exile. We pray for the faith and humility to be open to God's infinite grace, so all humanity might be open to God's life-giving love. Fr Jimmy
