As a seminarian in a parish one summer I made a ham sandwich for someone who came to the door. It was swiftly thrown back at me because, as the gentleman colourfully explained, he was a vegetarian. Nevertheless, my practice remains to give food or vouchers to someone who is begging rather than money.

A couple of weeks ago you all gave generously to the Priests' Training Fund. And while your donations go a long way towards the £25,000 per year costs of formation per student, you also have experience giving practically to the "growing" of a priest. During lockdown Tim Mangatal, now a priest, was here; then Deacon now Father - William Johnstone spent a year with us: the year after that, the now Deacon Robert Smialek made a huge contribution to the parish. At the same time both Fr Ben and Fr Alex are under-5s (in terms of years of Ordination) and therefore benefit from a regular programme of ongoing formation to make up for the many bad habits they learn from me. It's going to be a wonderful weekend so, as they seem to say these days, "save the date".

At the other end of the scale to all these young whippersnappers, your parish priest will be 25 on 3 July. As Fr Alex puts it, appropriately enough for the feast of St Thomas, "doubt no longer but believe" that Fr Kevin has lasted this long. And so I invite you to join me and my family and friends for Mass that day at 7:00pm when the Right Reverend George Archbishop-Emeritus of Cardiff, my first parish priest in 1999 and role-model, will preach.

And rest assured that at both do's there will be food to suit all dietary preferences. *Canon Kevin*
