DEEPENING OUR FAITH - AN INVITATION TO ALL ADULTS AND YOUNG ADULTS

These past 18 months have been very challenging for all of us, so I invite you now more than ever to COME and LISTEN to a series of catechesis for 8 weeks on Monday and Thursday evenings at 8 pm starting on 13th September 2021. Perhaps you have come in the past, perhaps you feel this is not for you, but I strongly encourage you to put these evenings aside and COME AND LISTEN at THIS time in your life. The Lord wants you to know Him, He has an answer to your fears and worries, He loves you and invites you to listen to Him.

BAPTISM PREPARATION FOR INFANTS has started, the next session will be on Wednesday at 6pm in the Church. Speak with Fr John if you want a place on the next course.

MARRIAGE PREPARATION There is the opportunity for a marriage preparation course (the same one as we were hoping to do) If you are looking for Marriage preparation, please ask Fr John.

CONFIRMATION & FIRST COMMUNION If your child or you are looking to make your Holy Communion or Confirmation, please ask for an application form, the courses will enrol soon. For Communion, you need to be in School Year 3 or above in September 2021 and for Confirmation in year 9 or above. If you want more information, please ask Fr John.

FR STEPHEN DELANY who for many years ministered in this parish, died on Monday 6th September in Italy. His funeral took place on Thursday 9th in Ivera, Italy. Fr Steve was an itinerant missionary with the Neocatechumenal way for many years, serving the church in Nigeria, Pakistan and South Africa and since 2010 in Denmark then near Milan. He looked after several seminarians over the years, some of whom went on to get married and have families, others went on to the priesthood. He was very faithful to the proclamation of the good news of the gospel and the dignity of the liturgy, although not a high liturgist in the more usual sense (incense and fine lace not always necessary). He could be short on tolerance when he saw the liturgy or the word of God in danger of being done badly, but was also known to apologise if he felt he had mistreated someone. Let us pray for the repose of his soul and for him and us that we can meet in the Lord's presence.

FR BRYAN JONES' headstone is now in place on his grave, and we hope parishioners will visit from time to time and say a prayer for him. St Patrick's Cemetery (tube station Leyton) opens for visitors 9.00 a.m. and during winter months closes at 4.00 p.m. Fr Bryan's grave is No 43, Row 6, in St Cecilia's Plot, which is in the new raised section of the cemetery, near the back hedge and the railway line.
