**SISTER KATHLEEN** who was here last Sunday at 6pm mass and the earlier masses 2 weeks before, says she is very happy and grateful for your listening to her and for your support.

**A BEAUTIFUL HALLMARK OF THE CATHOLIC FAITH is the profound desire to participate in the Holy Mass** and share in giving thanks and praise in the Eucharist. We do so with deep gratitude and joy. The Eucharist gives the Church her identity – *“The Eucharist makes the Church, and the Church makes the Eucharist.”*

Since the beginning of the Covid pandemic, until recently we have been restricted to some extent from doing this. So for some good reason we have followed mass online or in some instances been without mass at all.

In the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the Lord’s Supper, the Lord Jesus entrusted to us the precious gift of Himself. With humility, we glory in being a Eucharistic people for whom attendance at Mass is essential. Looking forward to this feast of Pentecost, all Catholics who have not yet done so are invited to return to attending Mass in person.

The ‘Obligation to attend mass on Sundays and Holy Days is not absolute, for example if someone needs looking after, child care, transport problems etc, or for a genuine reasonable fear. However now we are encouraged to return in freedom to the Mass: to join in this expression of praise and rejoicing, to join in the assembly of God, the community of faith.

**REREDOS ARTWORK.** Work has begun on phase 2. The artist who worked to produce the image of Christ in Glory at the centre of the High Altar screen found himself unable to produce the additional four phases of art originally quoted for in the time originally suggested or at the originally estimated prices. Phase Two is the two panels to the left and right of Christ, of Our Lady and St Peter and John the Baptist and St Paul. The time asked for this phase is up to 36 months and price to us rises from £7,200 to £12,000 per panel. Bearing in mind the money for the whole project at the original estimates has been raised or promised and we have been given permission by the Diocese to spend it, we can continue with phase two. However, I do not think we should go on with the further 3 phases without first asking the parish what you think and also finding another artist to assist this work. Please consider the beauty of our existing phase one: Christ in Glory, but also that the church has many parts to its mission apart from beautiful works of art. Please let me know what you think. Fr John.
