# "when true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth"

That is the kind of worshipper the Father wants .I have to ask my self this Lent, do I give joy to the Father's heart? I have to strive to be that kind of worshipper. I have to fix my thoughts and my heart on him, and my mind filled with his knowledge that has been imparted by the light of faith. I have to worship him in truth, that is, by my works for it's above all by my actions that I show that I am true: Which means I have to do what is pleasing to the Father, whose child I am. And I must worship through Jesus and with Jesus, for he alone is the true Worshipper in spirit and truth.

Then I will come to know that I am a child of God; I will know with an experiential knowledge that truth of what Isaiah says, '*At her breast will her nurslings be carried and fondled in her lap.* In god it seems wholly occupied with overwhelming the soul with caresses and marks of affection like a mother who brings up her child and feeds it with her own milk' (John of the Cross0., Let me be attentive to the mysterious voice of the Father! For he tells me my child be attentive to me.

God loved me, when I was dead through my many sins and yet he was generous with his mercy, and he brought me to life in Jesus. Both Jew and pagan sinned and forfeited God's glory, and both are justified through the free gift of his grace by being redeemed in Christ Jesus who was appointed by God to sacrifice his life so as to win reconciliation through faith. In this way God makes his justice known..., by showing positively that he is just, and that he justifies everyone who believes in him (Romans 3:23-26).

How can I keep from fainting in adoration when I plunge into the abyss of mercy and the eyes of my soul is fixed on this fact; God has taken away my sins for he has said; '*I it is, I it is, who must blot out everything and not remember your sins (Is 43:25).* Jesus in his mercy willed to turn my sins against themselves to my advantage. He found a way to make them useful for me, to convert them in my hands into a means of salvation. This shouldn't diminish in any way my horror of sinning, nor my sorrow for having sinned. But my sins have become a source of humility for me.

We encourage you to support out local choir London Docklands Singers, and to buy a ticket for this seasonal, musical event.


