

Four Years Comparison of Income and expenditure



I'm sure all of us know about the 'rise' in the cost of living over the last few years, higher gas, electric and water bills; two years ago, a dozen eggs cost £2.20, today £3.30. An average loaf of bread two years ago was about £1, now its £1.36. And so on...The simple graph above shows how the cost of living and the pandemic has affected the parish. Our total expenditure over the last four years has been much higher than our income, leaving us with a loss of £30,561 over that time. In the new year, all of us, together, will look at these figures in more detail and see how we can deal with this.
