**Reflection from Fr. Hilary** 

#### **The Blessed Trinity**

O World invisible, we view thee O World intangible, we touch thee O World unknowable, we know thee Inapprehensible, we clutch thee.

Well expressed and helpful in considering God Himself. With all that is so finite in our whole being we can never grasp God as the infinite. Yet, what the poet says above is wonderfully true. How? Because God has revealed himself to us in his Creation and especially in Christ. "He who has seen me has seen the Father." We are thus given powerful insights. If you think of 3 words we use frequently – **love**, **life**, **community** – we can have these insights by bearing in mind that these 3 words in their deepest and richest meaning **are** the magnificent reality of the life of God as Three Persons. God is Love. God is Life. God is Community. Who can deny that we all crave for Love, Life and Community? That's because we are made in His image. Well, we are offered them by the Lord.

Out of God's boundless Love, we are given the supreme Gift of the Holy Spirit. He is the unique Bond of Love, Bond of Unity between Father and Son. So then the Holy Spirit becomes the Bond of Love **uniting us also** to the Son as our Elder Brother. We are brothers and sisters of the Son in a most profound way, much deeper than ordinary blood relations. Therefore, we are brothers and sisters of each other. Finally, that makes us sons and daughters of God the Father sharing all that the Son IS and HAS as THE Son of the Father! What warmth, what love, what generosity.
