Reflection from Fr. Hilary: The Heart of the Matter

This poem alongside contains thought-provoking truths, urgent and beautiful written by Madeleine L'Engle. When you have read the first and second verses, you get the answer in the third verse. Honour and Truth and Love are trampled on today too. The inn is full – i.e. the greed and arrogance and selfishness of the world are rampant. That makes it all the more urgent for Love to be born – to be born much more in us all and to take the risk of **giving it birth**, bearing in mind this point: **the person who risks nothing risks far too much.** Very true. Once again please – prayerful reflection and help to spell it out to the children.
