**Reflection from Fr. Hilary: Appreciating the Word of God** - For your reflection following on from the Sunday of the Word of God

Please look closely at the following quotation:

"I ask you, brothers and sisters, tell me: which to you seems the greater, the word of God or the Body of Christ? If you wish to say what is true you will have to answer that the word of God is not less than the Body of Christ. Therefore just as when the Body of Christ is administered to us we take great care that nothing of it falls from our hands to the ground, so should we with equal care see that the word of God which is being imparted to us shall not be lost to our souls."

(St Caesarius of Arles, 470 – 543)

Maybe you are taken aback by that but I hope not! Rather, I hope you are thrilled like me! If we use a small "w" – the word of God or in the plural, the words of God over the many centuries preparing for Christ, we see how **all** that God the Father has to say is now summed up and fulfilled beyond expectation in His Son. This Son is **the** Word of God made flesh. "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God." The letter to the Hebrews says: "At various times in the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets but in our own time, he has spoken to us through His Son." Now please look at the next quotation from the Second Vatican Council (1965):

"The Church has always venerated the divine Scriptures just as she venerates the Body of the Lord, since from the table of **both** the word of God and of the body of Christ she receives and offers to the faithful the bread of life, especially in the sacred liturgy."

You can see now that this statement of the Second Vatican Council is saying the same as the first statement above! Great! So, Scripture is food as the Eucharist is food. Please – you must keep this for future reflection.

In addition to matching hosts with guests, the project has expanded to assist Ukrainians in the UK to find private rented accommodation at the end of their hosting period.
