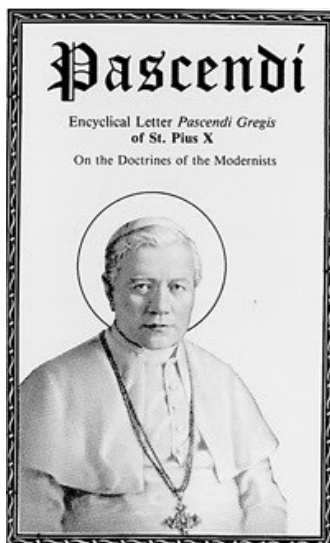
The Charism of Truth

Beloved,

Pope St Pius X fought vigorously against the heresy of Modernism which he regarded as 'the synthesis of all heresies'; as a manufactured toxin which endangered the faith of believers.

Modernism erroneously denies that God can be known by the light of reason, that miracles and prophecies are the surest signs of the divine origin of Christianity, that the Church was instituted by Christ and built upon Peter and his successors, that the doctrine of faith was faithfully handed down to us by the Apostles and that faith is a genuine assent of the intellect to the truth revealed by God. It erroneously teaches that faith can contradict history and that dogmas have nothing to do with the origins of Christianity. It studies the Scriptures without faith and sees nothing divine in the sacred tradition of the Church.

To counter these errors, the 'Oath Against Modernism,' introduced by Pius X in 1910, was to be sworn by all clergy, pastors, confes-

sors, preachers, religious superiors and professors in philosophical-theological seminaries. It was a profession of faith in all the truths opposed by Modernism. Its final sentences read:

'I hold to my dying breath the belief ... in the charism of truth, which certainly is, was and always will be in the succession of the episcopacy from the Apostles. The purpose of this is ... that the absolute and immutable truth preached by the Apostles from the beginning may never be believed to be different, may never be understood in any other way.'

It is nothing short of a miracle indeed that after more than a century filled with dissent, controversies and all kinds of errors, the truths which Modernists denied can be found perfectly intact in the current Catechism of the Catholic Church which is itself fruit of the very same 'charism of truth' which 'is, was and always will be' in the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.
