- 1. The meeting opened with a prayer from Fr John
- 2. Apologies: Tricia O'Neill, Annette Nosworthy
- 3. Minutes of last Meeting on Wednesday, 11th February 2015 were approved and accepted
- 4 Parish Report from Fr John:

Fr John introduced Moira Grethe as the new Parish Secretary, part-time hours on a Friday afternoon (14.30 - 17.30 can be flexible)

New jobs for the OHG Hall - Roof, Windows, and the insulation of the walls, also Heating; Puckeridge – Heating, Disabled Toilet, Kitchenette area

- 5 Matter arising from Minutes not covered by Fr John or the following agenda:
- (b) Fabric: New jobs for the OHG Hall Roof, Windows, and the insulation of the walls, Puckeridge Heating, Disabled Toilet, Kitchenette area
- (c) Puckeridge Disabled Toilet and a Kitchenette area; the removal of the Organ would give extra space for Communal use. *John Vaughan-Shaw said he had looked on eBay and the organ was of no value.* Perhaps a carpenter would like the wood from the organ?
- (d) Hall (OHG) Quote approx £6-7K, Wiring £2K etc is it worth the cost? especially as the Hall is not used to its full extent
- (e) Proposal for the changes to the hall, possibly removing the Fire Place? The hall would then look like a plain box with no character

- (f) Church (OHG) Floor covering cost about £18K, It was mentioned that Paul Howitt had previously stated that the condensation was not there before the carpet was put down, so a suggestion at the meeting was to remove the carpet to see if the problem continues. The carpet had been donated by Mrs Duffy, so it was felt before any decision was made, we contact Mrs Duffy.
- (g) Hall if the hall was to be used by more people/groups, then Rent should be charged, but it was stated that it was felt that the hall is in a difficult location and probably only be used by the current users Latin Mass Group, and the Parish.
- (h) Church Decision to be made but who makes these decisions, locally or higher and how? What is the proposed cost for all these projects, Is it the Parish who funds it or the Diocese? Fr John confirmed it was the Parish

6 Weekday / Holyday Masses: Fr John

Fr John suggested that we leave the Weekday Mass times as they are, as in the past there had been a trial occasion in Puckeridge when no-one turned up. The 2pm Mass for the school on Holydays would be kept, plus a 2.00pm Mass on Holydays when the school is not in session.

7 Extraordinary Ministers of Communion; Fr John

When Fr John is away, the sick and house bound need to be able to receive Holy Communion, *Marianne Ashcroft and Bernadette Pattie have* been approached, and a rota of Ministers would be drawn up

8 Parish Council:

Do we need a Parish Council? following discussions, it was felt that the open forum was more appropriate to the parish needs, and therefore it was agreed to leave the meeting as a "Open Meeting"

Challenges within the Parish, perhaps the meetings need to be scheduled more frequently, perhaps every 3 months, looking for the next meeting to be held in September

(9) Health and Safety

Puckeridge - Issue with the Mass taking place during the hours of darkness, a Fire *Warden* is required, and drill should take place after Mass, there is a torch in the Sacristy. A Fire *Warden* needs to be appointed, a note to be put in the newsletter. For Puckeridge it was suggested that until a Fire Warden is appointed, 1st Reader takes on the role, Fr John is first out, then Parishioners, and last the Fire Warden, making sure the building is clear,

A formal meeting will be arranged, proposing the duties involved, and written instructions handed out

(10) Website

There are 2 Parishes, Buntingford (BTF), Old Hall Green (OHG) and Puckeridge (PUCK) and Westminster wishes to keep them separate, so when you are searching the web, it is difficult to find the information regarding the other parishes

There is an error on the Buntingford site, showing the incorrect Weekday Mass time, it should be 09.30. Jacques will make the changes as required (**Rod DeSilva IT will be contacted by Fr John**)
