DO NOT BE AFRAID



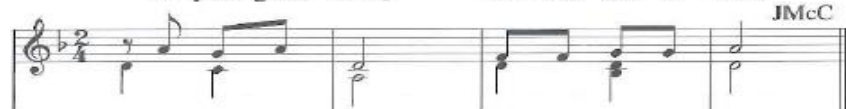
Psalm 68: In your great love, answer me, O God.

FEAST OF SAINTS PETER & PAUL
Thursday 29th June 2023 is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be two masses at 9.30 a.m. and 7.30 p.m.

PETER'S PENCE: The annual Peter's Pence collection takes place next Sunday 2nd July 2023. The proceeds are used to assist the Holy Father in his work.

SAINTS IN JUNE: The end of June is filled with feast days. For our diocese, the proximity of two of them is particularly significant. One is universal: the Solemnity of St Peter and St Paul on 29th June. It is a lovely occasion on which to ask their prayers: of Peter, entrusted by Christ with the mission of feeding his flock, sustaining the Church and being its rock; and of Paul, fearless preacher and the missionary disciple whose response to the exhortation to 'go out to the whole world and proclaim the good news' sets the standard for all others to follow.

A more local celebration is that of St John Southworth, our local martyr-saint whose body lies in the Cathedral. His feast day, on 27th June, is an occasion to remember with reverence and love his steadfastness of faith. He could have avoided martyrdom in his old age with one word, denying that he was a priest. He would not. He matched that courageous witness at the end with a pastoral ministry that was long and dedicated. An example of faith and perseverance to us all.

We ask the prayers of these great saints for the diocese and for the whole Church. We pray in particular for our new Apostolic Nuncio, Archbishop Miguel Maury Buendía, as his ministry to represent the successor of Peter in our country begins. And we pray in a special way for those who will, on 24th June, prostrate themselves in the Cathedral, close to the body of St John Southworth, as they are ordained

priests for the service of the Church in our diocese.

MASS REQUESTS

Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, e-mail, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. Offerings may be submitted by cheque or cash deposited in the lobby drop safe in a marked envelope, by BACS transfer (see bank details below), or by using the contactless machines. The minimum Diocesan recommendation

is £10. Masses are confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next available date will be allocated. In the event of a funeral, weekday masses may have to be rescheduled.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
