Isaiah 66:10-14. Towards her I send flowing peace, like a river.

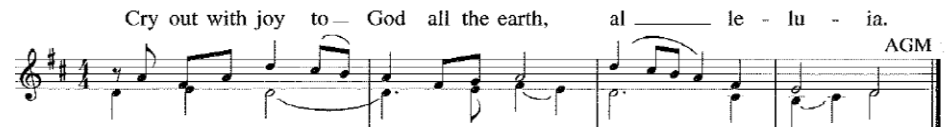
The prophet looks forward to the time when God's people will be restored to their homeland. The God who restores Israel is like a mother comforting her children.

Galatians 6:14-18. The marks on my body are those of the Lord Jesus. As he comes to the end of the letter, Paul offers a final summary of his thought. We are called to live by the grace of God, following the example of the life, death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Luke 10:1-12, 17-20. Your peace will rest on that man. In addition to the twelve apostles, Jesus sends out another seventy-two disciples. Their lives are to be striking examples of a level of trust in God that makes present among men and women the reality of God's reign.

CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP):

This is only applicable for parents who wish to send their children to a catholic (or Church of England) primary or secondary school. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the Certificate of Catholic Practice. To assist the parish in signing CCP forms, the parish operates a Mass attendance Card system.

Stickers for pupils in school Year 5 and under and Year 9 (for Year 12). Stickers will be given after Mass, before you leave. Stickers are not issued in August. It will be your responsibility to look after the card and bring it every week.
