2 Kings 4:8-11,14-16. This is a holy man of God; let him rest there. The wealthy woman of Shunem receives the gift of a baby boy through the intercession of the pophet Elisha. Such a gift stems from her graciousness in providing regular hospitality for others.

Romans 6:3-4,8-11. When we were baptised we went into the tomb with Christ, so that we too might live a new life. Through baptism the Christian shares in the transforming of Jesus' death/resurrection. In turn, the believer is challenged to live out the consequences of this saving event by imitating the lifestyle of Jesus in service to others.

Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, e-mail, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. Offerings may be submitted by cheque or cash deposited in the lobby drop safe in a marked envelope, by BACS transfer (see bank details below), or by using the contactless machines. The minimum Diocesan recommendation is £10. Masses are confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next available date will be allocated. In the event of a funeral, weekday masses may have to be rescheduled.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) will be

required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
