Once the Funeral arrangements have been finalised they will be made known to parishioners.

In the meantime, the Sunday Masses at 9 am, 11.30 am and 6 pm will be celebrated as usual. On weekdays, Mass will only be celebrated on **Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday at 9.30 am**. There will be no Benediction, and Confession will be on call. If you have arranged for a Mass to be offered for a particular intention on Tuesday or Thursday, they will be re-allocated to a later date. If you contact the parish office (preferably by email), you can find out the new date. Intentions are also publicised in the Sunday newsletter for the following week.

The church will continue to be open on weekdays for private prayer, but will have to close earlier than was previously the case.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
