6th August 2023 Transfiguration of the Lord Year A Part 2 (Pg. 173)



Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14. His robe was white as snow.

In a dream depicting a divine judgement, Daniel assures faithful Jews that the Lord will deliver them from their persecutors and, in solidarity with one 'as a son of man', give them an eternal kingdom.

2 Peter 1:16-19. We heard this ourselves, spoken from heaven. Jesus' transfiguration is the revelation and guarantee of his final triumph in his 'Parousia' (i.e. Second Coming), as well as being the fulfilment of the Old Testament which, in turn, is a sure guide on our faith journey.

THE PARISH GARDENS & FR MARK:

As mentioned in last Sunday's newsletter, Fr Mark loved his garden and spent a lot of time in it. He liked to leave the lawn to grow like a meadow, so that wild flowers could grow and the bees and butterflies could visit. In the middle of August it is all cut down again, as that is how one manages a meadow. This allows all the seeds to disperse and grow again next year. This explains why the garden grass has been so tall, as it was part of Fr. Mark's rewilding project. This was very close to his heart. The simple posy on his coffin was made using flowers picked from the parish garden, at the request of his family.

Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, e-mail, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. The minimum Diocesan recommendation is £10. Masses are confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next available date will be allocated. In the event of a funeral, weekday masses may have to be rescheduled.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
