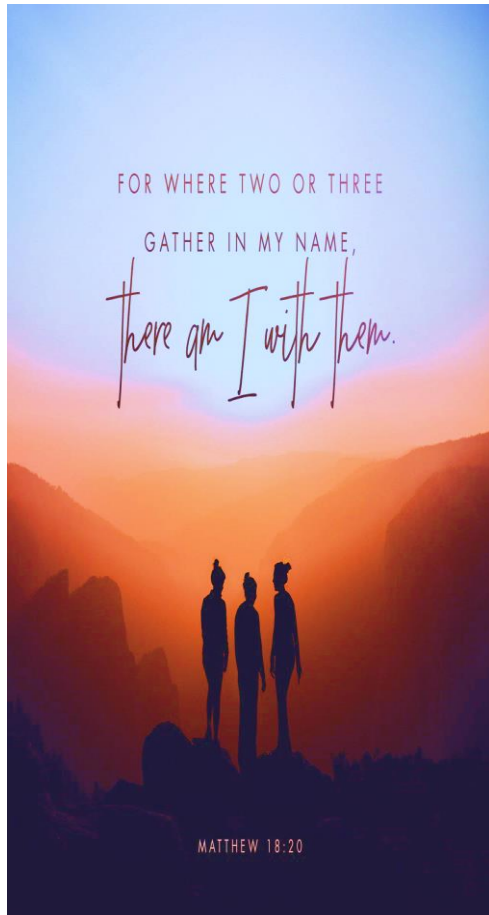

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A Part 2 (Pg. 125)



Ezekiel 33:7-9. If you do not speak to the wicked man, I will hold you responsible for his death. The message of Ezekiel oscillates between doom and hope. Today's reading presents him as a sentry keeping watch over the house of Israel, sent to warn them of the consequences of forgetting God and turning against the God-given Law.

Romans 13:8-10. Love is the answer to every one of the commandments. What is the essence of the Law for Christians? Everything forbidding adultery, murder, theft, and covetousness is presupposed. Yet there is a deeper and more challenging law, that of loving your neighbour as yourself.

Matthew 18:15-20. If he listens to you, you have won back your brother. Even in the early days, soon after the Resurrection of the Lord, the Christian community had to face scandals in its midst. Jesus teaches his community how to deal with offenders, beginning with a quiet one-to-one word of advice but if necessary, involving also community mediation.

MASS REQUESTS

Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, e-mail, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. Offerings may be submitted by cheque or cash deposited in the lobby drop safe in a marked envelope, by BACS transfer (see bank details below), or by using the contactless machines. The minimum Diocesan recommendation is £10. Masses are confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next

available date will be allocated. In the event of a funeral, weekday masses may have to be rescheduled.

NOTE: Whilst there are Eucharistic services in place, masses are currently being booked on Sunday only and the diary is currently full for this year.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
