Ecclesiasticus 27:30-28:7. Forgive your neighbour the hurt he does you, and when you pray, your sins will be forgiven. A Jewish teacher, writing about 200 years before the time of our Lord, insists that life is too short to harbour resentment or to plan vengeance.

Romans 14:7-9. Alive or dead we belong to the Lord. If the life and death of each of us has consequences for others, this applies all the more to our relationship with God in Christ.

Matthew 18:21-35. I do not tell you to forgive seven times, but seventy-seven times. Peter, on behalf of the apostles, wants Jesus to give an exact figure for how often we should forgive. Instead, Jesus tells a challenging parable of a man who was forgiven a gigantic debt, but refused to forgive a much smaller debt.

Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, email, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. The minimum Diocesan recommendation is £10. Masses are confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next available date will be allocated. A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE

(CCP) will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
