Isaiah 5:1-7. The vineyard of the Lord of hosts is the House of Israel. Using the image of a landowner investing in a vineyard, the prophet tells of how much God has done for his people. But this investment has not produced the fruits of justice.

PSALM 79: The vineyard of the Lord is the House of Israel.

Philippians 4:6-9. The God of peace will be with you. For Paul, thanksgiving is at the heart of our prayer, and of our search for what is noble and true and good.

Matthew 21:33-43. He will lease the vineyard to other tenants. In the parable, the son thrown out of the vineyard and killed there, clearly represents Jesus crucified outside the city.

2024: Applications are now invited for children to prepare for the Sacraments of First Communion and Reconciliation at St Vincent's in 2024. Application forms are available in paper form in the forms box in the Church lobby or via the parish website (in the **Forms** section beneath

Applicants must be baptised Catholics, be in Year 3 or above at school and the family must be registered with the parish using registration pack available in the lobby of the church and attend Mass regularly at St Vincent's. Completed forms must be accompanied by a copy of the child's

baptism certificate. These should be posted through the parish office door. It is intended that the programme of classes/meetings will begin in early January 2024 and that the First Communion Masses will be held in mid-May 2024.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP)

will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below). To obtain an
