

Isaiah 40:1-5.9-11. Prepare a way for the Lord. This prophet of the exile proclaims to his discouraged and disheartened audience that their God is making a new initiative. It is now time for comfort and consolation. The Lord will lead his people home across the desert to their own land.

Psalm 84: Let us see, O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help.

2 Peter 3:8-14. We are waiting for the new heavens and new earth. Speaking to people who had doubts about Jesus' second coming, the author teaches that the delay of this coming reflects God's patience and concern. Their hope for this great event should contribute to lives of holiness and godliness:

such lives will hasten the longed for day.

Mark 1:1-8. Make his paths straight. Assuming the clothing and lifestyle of the prophet Elijah, John the Baptist announces God's unexpected plan of salvation – indeed one unfolding in the desert. He calls, therefore, for a radical conversion that is symbolized by baptism. As a precursor, he proclaims the coming of a mightier one.

MASS REQUESTS: Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, by e-mail, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. Offerings may be submitted by cheque or cash deposited in the lobby drop safe in a marked envelope, by BACS transfer (see bank details below), or by using the contactless machines.

The minimum Diocesan recommendation is ± 10 . Masses are confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next available date will be allocated. In the event of a funeral, weekday masses may have to be rescheduled.

PARISH REGISTRATION: Collect a Welcome Pack from the lobby. Completed Registration and Planned Giving forms can be posted into the lobby safe. Please inform the office if your details change.

MARRIAGES: 6 months' notice required. Please contact Fr Feroz Fernandes via the Parish Office.

BAPTISM: For parishioners registered and attending at St. Vincent's, complete a Baptism Application form (available in the lobby or online) and submit to the Parish Office with your offering. You will be contacted thereafter.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP)

will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below). To obtain an application form for a CCP, or for enquiries, email Antonella <u>osterleyccp1@rcdow.org.uk</u> (using a digit1).
