

I Samuel 3:3-10,19. Speak, Lord, your servant is listening. If we would be bearers of peace to our world, we need to become like the child, Samuel. We need to become aware that God is calling us. We need to make his prayer our own: "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening."

PSALM 39: Here I am Lord! I come to do your will.

1 Corinthians 6:13-15, 17-20. Your bodies are members making up the body of Christ. Soul and body are a unity prepared for the indwelling of the Holy Spirit by the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. MASS REQUESTS: Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, by e-mail, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. Offerings may be submitted by cheque or cash deposited in the lobby drop safe in a marked envelope, by BACS transfer (see bank details above), or by using the contactless machines. The minimum Diocesan recommendation is £10. Masses will

be confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next available date will be allocated. In the event of a funeral, weekday masses may have to be rescheduled.

BAPTISM: For parishioners registered and attending at St. Vincent's, complete a Baptism Application form (available in the lobby or online) and submit to the Parish Office with your offering. You will be contacted thereafter.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP)

will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
