Leviticus 13:1-2,44-46. The leper must live apart: he must live outside the camp. In the Old Testament legislation on leprosy, those affected had to live apart and warn anyone who approached them of their condition. This legislation was still in force in the time of Christ.

PSALM 31: You are my refuge, O Lord; you fill me with the joy of salvation

One Corinthians 10:31-11:1. Take me for your model, as I take Christ. Paul tells the Christians of Corinth that they should always act in a manner that gives glory to God and that benefits others.

Mark 1:40-45. The leprosy left him at once and he was cured. A man with leprosy approaches Jesus who cures him by touch, and by commanding the leprosy to disappear.

MASS REQUESTS: Mass intentions can be requested via the parish office, by e-mail, or by using a donation envelope from the lobby, which allows you to gift aid your offering. Offerings may be submitted by cheque or cash deposited in the lobby drop safe in a marked envelope, by BACS transfer (see bank details provided), or by using the contactless

machines. The minimum Diocesan recommendation is £10. Masses will be confirmed upon receipt of the stipend. If the requested date is already booked, the next available date will be allocated. In the event of a funeral, weekday masses may have to be rescheduled.

MARRIAGES: 6 months' notice required. Please contact Fr Feroz Fernandes via the Parish Office.

BAPTISM: For parishioners registered and attending at St. Vincent's, complete a Baptism Application form (available in the lobby or online) and submit to the Parish Office with your offering. You will be contacted thereafter.

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING A CATHOLIC? Did you miss out on one or more of the sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation? Please make contact with the Parish Office, and we can direct you to one of our programmes.

A CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) will be required for applications to Catholic (or Church of England & Faith) primary or secondary schools. The Diocese requires that families attend regularly (this means attending Mass every Sunday) for at least two years before a priest is able to sign the CCP. To assist the priest in signing the certificate, the parish operates a Mass Attendance Card system (see below).
