Acts 4:8-12. This is the only name by which we can be saved. The first Christians sought to understand the identity of Jesus was to apply an image from the Psalms: the stone rejected, has become the corner-stone. Jesus was rejected and put to death, but he has been raised and glorified by the Father.

Psalm 117: The stone which the builders rejected has become the corner stone.

1 John 3:1-2. We shall see God as he really is. We are loved by God, we are the children of God, we can dare to address God in familiar terms.

John 10:11-18. The good shepherd is one who lays down his life for his sheep. In trials the shepherd must not abandon the flock, and if needs be he lays down his life for them. This is a key image in our understanding of Jesus and Christian love.

PRIEST TRAINING FUND

This Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday and our second collection will support the Priest Training Fund.

This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 49 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 13 of whom are from our own Diocese. We also have one seminarian in Valladolid and one at the Beda, presently on pastoral placement in Ruislip. There are also two on a propaedeutic year at Redemptoris Mater. Last year 3 deacons were ordained for Westminster Diocese.

The Priest Training Fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests. Your gift ensures we can provide training for these men responding to Christ's call to dedicate their lives to serve God's people. Please be as generous as you can. Trusting in God, it began as a dream to build a new place of worship at St. Vincent de Paul, Osterley. The inspired dream continues with your fervent prayers, generous contribution and volunteer spirit. We are yet to pay £579,812.79 of the loan undertaken in 2004 to build this new Church. The good news is that we are still on track to complete payments by 2034.

But factors beyond our control, like a spike in interest rates, inflation, and disruption due to COVID-19, impacted our timeline on the payments, leading to a negative cash flow. We are committed to paying off £35,347.00 capital in 2024, plus £33,678 interest on the loan at 5.7%, so total we need this year is £69,025. We trust God and rely on your prayers and contribution to catch up on the agreed timeline of payments.
