If you are applying to Catholic Secondary Schools, worship at St John Fisher Church and need a Certificate of Catholic Practice, please contact the parish office. You will need to provide your child's full name, home address and date of birth.

If you are applying to a school that requires you to provide a SIF (Supplementary Information Form) which requires Fr Peter's signature, please bring the form with you to any of the weekday or weekend Masses and see Fr Peter after Mass.
