NOCTURNAL ADORATION

You are invited to spend time before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament during this very special liturgical moment of the year. He invites us all: "Watch with me". Please choose an hour and sign up on the sheet at the back of the church. This will guarantee that every hour there will be a number of people present. Otherwise, you may come at any moment spontaneously and stay for as long or as short as you like at the hour you wish.

Our young people (Youth Outreach) have chosen to come to adoration at 2:00 until 3:00 in the morning. Parents of minors are asked to ensure that they come accompanied and leave accompanied due to the hour.
