Next Sunday, June 2nd is the feast of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ). This year we will have such a procession, meeting in front of the church and setting off at 15:00. Our route will take us up the A40 turning right just before the Hoover building on Rydal Crescent, right again on Coniston Ave, then again on Thirlmere Ave until we get back to the A40, turning left at the bus stop towards the Church. We will conclude with benediction. All parishioners are invited to come and manifest publicly their faith in Jesus Christ. It shouldn't take more than 45 mins.
