Let's pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory: November is the month the Church devotes to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. What is Purgatory? Is it the place we have to go to be punished for our sins? Is it God's way of getting us back for the wrong we've done? None of these questions really answer the question of Purgatory.

Purgatory is nothing other than the burning and purifying love of our God in our lives! When someone dies in God's grace they are most likely not 100% perfect in every way. Even the greatest of saints most often would have some imperfection left in their lives. Purgatory is nothing other than that final purification of all remaining attachment to sin in our lives. Purgatory is the process, after death, of burning out the last of our attachments so that we can enter Heaven 100% freed of everything to do with sin. we are called to pray for those in Purgatory.
