As we are now in our third Sunday of Advent it is called Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete means "rejoice" and we are all prompted to this emotional action by concentrating, not just on Christ's Second Coming, but on His birth as well. It can be said that joy comes from within; it can be experienced independently of any external stimulus, but for many of us the stimuli are, in fact, all around us and pretty inescapable. The increase of lights and decorations, Christmas trees, Christmas Cribs, shops alight with festive goods, the appearance of foodstuffs we would not normally see grouped on supermarket shelves, the plethora of marketing temptations available through various communications media, the total excitement of seeing people who live far away returning to us for Christmas. And yet. For some there will be gaps at Christmas festivities, there will be the emotional pain that gets in the way of any semblance of "Gaudete". There will be none of the commercial glitter for those still grieving the loss of their loved ones, there is only the consolation of God through all possible means. We, as Church and not just as a parish, will know and keep the realisation in our hearts of the grief many feel now and for many times afterwards. It is our individual mission to instil wherever we can the emotional transition from grief to absolute JOY, the joy that comes from the realisation of life everlasting through Jesus Christ and His coming Birth.
