2023 -2024 YEAR OF PRAYER

Pope Francis' Catechesis on Prayer, arranged for each liturgical week First Week of Advent - Sunday 3rd December 2023: For this Sunday's Mass in our second scripture reading (1 Cor 1: 3-9), St Paul thanks God for all the graces the Corinthian church has received through Christ: "I never stop thanking God for all the graces you have received through Jesus Christ ..." Pope Francis teaches the importance of thanksgiving to God in prayer in his catechesis given on 30th December 2020. In this catechesis he starts by reflecting on the ten healed lepers, only one of whom came back to say thanks (Lk 17:13 ff). There is a major division between those who thank and those who do not. Francis challenges us as to whether we really see ourselves as being given gifts, or only have a sense of entitlement (a sense of, "I am owed this"). A sense of thanksgiving always grows when there is true encounter with Jesus. (Pope Francis' catechesis on prayer by Fr Rob Taylerson)

<u>Action Prayer</u>: "Stay Awake!" Our readings this weekend are reminding us to be alert because we don't know when Our Lord is coming...

Jesus' request to his disciples to stay awake happens more than once in the bible! He was well aware of our human flaws and how our minds, and hearts, can wander even when we mean well. What does staying awake, being alert mean? What do we need to be aware of? Our Action Prayer this week will be to ask God those two questions, preferably in a contemplative state. Most likely the answer will become clear when you least expect it! Remember last week's gospel "what you do to the least of these...".
