**ACTION PRAYER:** It's the third weekend of Lent. Our readings deliver the Ten Commandments, St Paul justifies preaching the crucifixion and Jesus chases the sellers and the money changers out of the temple.

That's a fair amount of tension. There's a probability we are feeling some personal tension too--it *is* the middle of Lent. Plus, there's planetary hot spots and reminders of our poor stewardship with nature. How are we responding? How are we handling the spiritual. emotional, mental and physical challenges? The last line in the gospel was "...he could tell what a man had in him." Our **Action Prayer** is to spend at least 10 minutes several times this week in absolute silence with the thought, *Jesus, please fill me with what I need.* Then sit still and just *be*. Jesus doesn't need a back story or a justification. Jesus just desires to *be* with you. Powerful and Healing
