Today being the Fourth Sunday of Easter is the Good Shepherd Sunday, we are invited to pray for vocations to the priesthood, as well as for our seminarians at the Royal English College in Valladolid, Allen Hall in Chelsea, The Venerable English College, and the Beda College in Rome. We pray that the Holy Spirit will stir the hearts of our young men to discern further a vocation to the priesthood. This year, we have 49 men studying at Allen Hall, of whom 13 are from our own Diocese. We also have one seminarian in Valladolid and one at the Beda, presently on pastoral placement. There are also two on a Propaedeutic Year at Redemptoris Mater. Last year, 3 Deacons were ordained for Westminster Diocese. We look forward to ordinations this summer. The cost of the formation of the Westminster seminarians will have been borne by the Priest Training Fund (PTF). Our Second collection today will support the PTF. Please pray for vocations and for all our priests, Thank you very much indeed for generosity and support.

ACTION PRAYER: Recognition is the theme this weekend. God recognises Jesus, Jesus recognises us and how we should recognise Him.

The Good Shepherd is our model of recognition--both the shepherd and the sheep know each other. They are in the same *fold*, and have a relationship of trust and love. Jesus speaks of his sheep knowing his voice. When we pray with God, we aren't just speaking words in his direction. We are listening to his voice, learning his voice, knowing his voice.

Our **Action Prayer** this week is while doing a meditative prayer, ideally in any natural setting, lets reread the line from Sunday's gospel, "*And there are other sheep I have that are not of this fold, and these I have to lead as well.*" Let's ask Jesus what this passage means for us, to help us to understand and we'll listen to his voice.
