The 2nd Sunday of Easter is known as the Divine Mercy Sunday. Our devotion to the risen Christ via Divine Mercy prayer is connected to the spirituality of Saint Faustina, a Polish mystic and religious Sister who was canonized by Pope Saint John Paul II, who died on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday in 2005, was beatified on Divine Mercy Sunday in 2011, and was canonized on Divine Mercy Sunday in 2014. Saint John Paul II decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would be kept each year as Divine Mercy Sunday, and this beautiful title draws our attention today to the way in which that mercy is ordinarily extended to us. Today's Gospel speaks of the divine power to forgive sins which the Lord Jesus gave to his Apostles when he first appeared to them after his Resurrection, the emphasis of the liturgy today is on the great mercy of God.
