Leaving is not abandoning ...

It seems that the disciples had no direction to carry on the Mission after Christ's Ascension. Anyone could consider this as total abandonment.

The reality, however, is that Christ is still with them. What impresses me is that most probably the disciples heard Jesus praying to the Father the prayer we hear in today's Gospel. Just as many times we consider Christ at the right hand of the Father, pleading mercy for us, he also asks his Father to continue to sustain us.

And this mystical sustenance comes from a living community that shows the signs of love and unity. These signs are often difficult to point out or decipher because it comes with a supernatural grace. Christ leaves us in this world to continue being witnesses of the resurrection and the promise of eternal life. He leaves us, but does not abandon us to our own whim. The First Reading shows that the community needed to continue its mission and carry on in its life for the salvation of souls with the election of Matthias (whose feast day is this Tuesday).

Let us pray for the inspiration of the Holy Spirit this week in order to continue the mission entrusted to us for more than 2000 years.
