SUNDAY THOUGHT

Sometimes we have a smidgen of an idea, and when we respond to the prompting of the idea it begins to grow and become something concrete and practical. For example, redecorating a room might begin with a choice of colour and grow from there. A birthday party might begin with an idea for a theme cake and grow from there. A garden plot might begin with one seed and grow from there. What begins small might end up quite large.

Faith and faithfulness are similar. They begin and grow slowly as we respond to God's promptings within us calling us to be servants. Being a servant is not a matter of obeying single commands, but of assuming a way of living in which we are constantly responding to needs around us.

If we ask God for an increase of faith, we are really asking for an increase of faithfulness – an increase of obedience, an increase in responding to the needs around us. Our faithfulness is increased when we, for example, persist as parents in rearing our children in right values, persist as labourers in putting in an honest day's work, persist as friends in guiding and supporting one another. The faithful disciple of Jesus is never finished serving. The faith of a disciple is never finished increasing.
