2ND SUNDAY OF LENT (YEAR A) 12TH MARCH 2017

SUNDAY THOUGHT

"Lord, it is wonderful for us to be here." Peter exclaimed this because he saw the transfigured Jesus, the glory of God. But when Jesus was nailed to the cross, where was Peter? It certainly would have been wonderful for Peter to have been there to witness the self-giving love of the Saviour–God that is also his glory. How many times Peter could have repeated his exclamation: at the crucifixion, the resurrection, the ascension, at Pentecost, at his own martyrdom.

"Lord, it is wonderful for us to be here." Where are they? How did they get there? Peter, James and John are on the mountaintop where they see Jesus shining in full divine glory. They got there by following Jesus' own footsteps. But their journey does not end "here". They must follow Jesus' footsteps down the mountain to the daily challenges and demands of discipleship where they must also learn to exclaim, "Lord, it is wonderful for us to be here."

"Lord, it is wonderful for *us* to be here." Where are we? This is *the* question of Lent that we must answer on our journey of discipleship. We climb to the mountaintop of glory only from the solid plain of ordinary human living. It is "here" in our everyday decisions that salvation comes to us. It is "here" in our encounters with Jesus that we journey fully and lovingly in his footsteps. Wherever Jesus is, it is wonderful for us to be "here" – with him.
