# THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI) - 18<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2017

# **SUNDAY THOUGHT**

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, popularly known as *Corpus Christi* (Latin for 'The Body of Christ'), is a devotional feast established in 1264 in order to celebrate the greatest gift Jesus Christ left us – his real and true presence among us under the appearance of bread and wine. Even more so than the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, which also focuses on Christ's washing of his disciples' feet and the institution of the priesthood, *Corpus Christi* allows us to reflect on how Jesus has made himself so intimately available to us in the food and drink of his Body and Blood.

Not only does participating in Mass and receiving Jesus in his Body and Blood allow us to share in Christ's saving work, as all the sacraments do, but in receiving Holy Communion we receive the very source of our salvation, Jesus Christ himself. For this reason, Mass, the Eucharist, is the highest sacrament and the sacrament to which all the others are directed.

In receiving Holy Communion, not only do we share in Jesus' own divine life, but through him we also affirm our 'holy communion' with the Church which, as St. Paul tells us, is the mystical 'Body of Christ'. Our being part of the mystical 'Body of Christ' is effected by our receiving the physical Body of Christ. Receiving Holy Communion is therefore never a private devotion, a relationship just between Jesus and me. It takes part within the Church and includes all our brothers and sisters who are also members of the Church.

We should always make sure we are properly prepared to receive Jesus' Body and Blood by ensuring our 'holy communion' with him is strong; by committing our love to him, by turning away from our sins and asking for his forgiveness, and by our obedience to what he asks of us in his teachings through his Bride, the Church. In this way we are able to receive the full treasure of the priceless gift that is Jesus' real presence in his Body and Blood. 'O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine.'

#### **REGISTRATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2018**

In July Fr Shaun will be registering children wishing to make their First Communion in 2018. To be eligible children must be in Year 3 or above by September 2017 and attend Mass regularly in one of the three parishes. The expectation is that all children preparing for Holy Communion should already know how to make the sign of the cross and know the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be. These prayers should be taught and prayed in the home regularly. Parents may bring their child for registration on the following dates: **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July** – Our Lady's Church Hall, Rickmansworth – 5.00pm to 6.00pm

Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July – Our Lady's Church Hall, Rickmansworth – 5.00pm to 6.00pm Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> July – St John the Evangelist *Church*, Mill End – 2.00pm to 3.00pm

It is essential that you bring with you to the meeting the child wishing to be prepared for Holy Communion. If your child was baptised somewhere other than Our Lady Help of Christians Rickmansworth, St John Fisher Chorleywood or St John the Evangelist, Mill End you will need to bring with you the child's baptismal certificate. You are welcome to bring your child to whichever of the registration times is best for you. There is no need to make a particular appointment, please just come along during the appointed times. Do not worry if the place of registration is not your usual church for Sunday Mass attendance.

# THREE PARISH WALKING PILGRIMAGE TO SANTIAGO DI COMPOSTELA, VIA THE PORTUGUESE COASTAL ROUTE – 26<sup>TH</sup>MAY TO 2<sup>ND</sup> JUNE 2018

Booking is now open for our 2018 walking pilgrimage to Santiago via the last 100km of the Portuguese Coastal route. The shortest day's walk will be 9.3 miles and the longest will be 15.5 miles and the total distance walked will be about 79.5 miles (128km). The pilgrimage is being organised through Camino Ways and more details of the route can be found on their website at: http://caminoways.com/ways/portuguese-coastal-way-caminho-da-costa/portuguese-coastal-way-section-2 The cost of the pilgrimage will be €868 (c. £738) per person (sharing a twin room) or €1,052 (c. £894) for a single room. <u>Please note that there is only one single room available</u>. Flights are <u>not</u> included and are being arranged separately. Included in the price are local transfers between Porto airport and hotel (and return), a local tour guide, transfer of luggage along the route and half-board (breakfast and dinner) throughout. Information about the pilgrimage, about the arrangements being offered regarding the booking of flights and how to book a place on the pilgrimage are all available in the parishes this weekend and also on all three parish websites.

#### MEMORIAL STONES FOR THE GARDEN OF REST

The Parish Pastoral Council has been considering how we might better commemorate all those whose ashes lie in our Garden of Rest and it has been decided to commission two "boulder-like" stones, each of which will have a flat stone plate affixed to the front of it, to be inscribed with the names of those whose ashes are interred in the Garden of Rest. We are now trying to contact the next of kin to ask two things: firstly, whether they would like the name of their departed loved one(s) added to the stone and, if so, how you would wish the name to be commemorated on the plaque. There will only be room for a first name and a surname. Secondly, the two stones and the inscribed plaques will cost in the region of £3,500 and so we would like to invite those with a loved one buried in the garden to consider making a donation toward this. We are not suggesting any particular amount but would simply ask families to consider what they feel might be possible and appropriate. Unfortunately we do not have all of the details for all of the next of kin in the parish records. If you are in contact with someone who has moved away from the parish or who doesn't attend Mass here and whom you know has a loved one interred in our Garden of Rest, we would be most grateful if you could ask them to contact Kerry in the Parish Office. In the coming few weeks we will be writing directly to the next of kin for whom we have addresses. We hope that the memorial stones, with the inscribed names, will be installed later this year.
