## EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION 21<sup>ST</sup> APRIL 2019

### SUNDAY THOUGHT

Throughout Lent we have been following Our Lord, with fasting, prayer and almsgiving. We have walked alongside him through the betrayal, scourging, mocking, and agonising last hours of Hour Week. And today we joyfully and gratefully share with him in the victory of the Resurrection.

Still even now, as we celebrate this greatest feast in our calendar, we know that war continues, that children are starving to death, that families are torn apart, that precious lives are destroyed for a myriad of reasons. We live in a world where humans beings are reduced to things which can be bought or sold, used or not used, broken and then thrown away. For millions of people Easter is no time of hope. Yet ours is not a God who stands far off, but one who experienced from the inside all that is ugliest in humanity. He has come close to us by sharing our human condition, by suffering betrayal and torture, and by dying a most horrific death.

“Go and find my brothers and tell them”, Christ will say to Mary Magdalene (Jn 20:17). He calls her by name to a new act of service: to bear the message and the truth of the Resurrection - there is no evil, no desolation, that is beyond the scope of God’s power to heal. Today we too are called to find Christ’s brothers and sisters, and to tell them of our encounter with the risen Christ and the reason for our rejoicing: we rejoice because we no longer need to live burdened by the sin we struggle with, or in the shame of a past we can’t forget. Through Christ’s death we died to sin, and through his Resurrection we are born anew, and granted eternal life with him in Paradise. We rejoice because Easter has the most profound, joyous, importance for our own humdrum lives, filling them with a new light and purpose.

As we gather together to celebrate the Risen Lord, we find this is not the end, but only the beginning of a further journey - to go out to the whole world and proclaim the Good News! “He is not here, for he is risen”, ALLELUIA!
