SUNDAY THOUGHT

Peacemaker and reconciler – how often do we see ourselves in that role or act in that capacity? Yet this is the message and work we have been given, the “responsibility” we have for one another.

The directive given on this matter in today’s Gospel concerns a brother (or sister) in the Church. The Church is the new people of God, called by and gathered around Jesus.

The “how” of exercising this work of conversion and reconciliation is set forth in the first lines of the Gospel reading and tempered by the Second Reading, which reminds us that love of neighbour must be the basis of any work of reconciliation.

Today’s Scriptures call us to self-examination, for we are both sinners in need of our own conversion and called to be “prophets” and reconcilers for one another.

Let us listen to God’s voice whenever and through whomever God speaks, and harden not our hearts.

Last weekend we launched the livestreaming of Mass from Our Lady’s. From the many emails we have received this past week, we know how much this means to so many of you. As I have said before, I believe that our ability to livestreaming Mass will play an important part in keeping us united as a community of three parishes in the (very likely) challenging circumstances of autumn and winter.

I am delighted to say that, thanks to the generosity of so many of you, we have been able to cover the full cost of the installation of the livestreaming equipment, without having to dip into existing parish funds, at a time when they are obviously under some pressure. In fact, we exceeded our target of £6,000, raising over of £8,000! The monies donated over and above the installation costs will be ‘ring-fenced’ and allocated to the payment of the monthly streaming and system maintenance fees.

Your incredible generosity is so very much appreciated. Thank you!

CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE – ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/22 – UPDATED INFORMATION

The assessment of whether a CCP can be issued will be made in the following way:

Secondary Transfer: Only the Sundays from the **beginning of October 2019 until and including Sunday 15th March 2020** will be assessed. Further, given the unprecedented nature of the situation, I will be reducing the requirement from 70% attendance to 65% attendance. This will mean that you will need **16** out of a possible **24** stickers in order for a CCP to be issued. Fr Shaun will be available to sign CCPs at the following times in the parish hall:

Monday 5th October: 5 pm – 6 pm

Wednesday 10th October: 6 pm – 7 pm

Saturday 10th October: 11 am to 12 noon

You will need to book a specific (5 minute) appointment time by calling Kerry, our Parish Administrator, on 01923 773387 Ext 2, between 9.30am and 3.00pm Monday to Friday. Only one parent (no children) should attend the appointment. Please arrive 5 minutes before your appointment time and remember to bring your sticker card with you.

Nursery/Reception (*this does not include St John's school, Mill End, where a CCP is no longer a requirement*): Only the Sundays from the **beginning of December 2019 until and including Sunday 15th March 2020** will be assessed. Again, the requirement of 70% attendance will be reduced to 65% attendance. This will mean that you will need **10** out of a possible **15** stickers in order for a CCP to be issued. In November 2020, I will set out arrangements for the signing of CCPs in November 2020. *Fr Shaun.*

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2021

Due to the pandemic, the preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion for 2021 will not commence until **January 2021**. Registration will take place in November 2020. Details of the programme have yet to be finalized, but is almost certain that the format will be remote sessions (via Zoom) for the children and parent(s) together. More details will be available at the time of registration in November.

THE BOOKING OF MASSES

We are looking forward to reopening for Mass next Sunday. There are just a few things we need to draw your attention to:

- As numbers will be limited, we will be operating an online booking system. This will go live on Monday 7th September on the Parish Website. If you are attending as part of a family group or social "bubble" please ensure to make clear on your booking as that will allow us to allocate seating appropriately and maximise the numbers that can attend.
- Please be aware that, in order to maintain a 2m social distance, it will not be possible to kneel during Mass.
- So that the stewards can seat you safely we ask that you please arrive **no earlier than 20 minutes and no later than 5 minutes before the time the Mass is due to start.**
- **It is now mandatory to wear a face covering in places of worship.** We kindly ask you to please bring a face covering with you.

You may already be aware that we had a break-in at the church about a week ago. Although we don't believe anything of significance was stolen, there was some damage. The biggest problem is that the intruder tried to gain access through the rear patio doors and whilst unsuccessful the damage is such that we are currently unable to open the doors. As this is both a fire exit and a source of ventilation if we are unable to get it repaired in time this may prevent us reopening. We are very hopeful that we will have at least a temporary solution in time, but it is only right to flag up this possibility now rather than nearer the time.
