EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR C) - 31st JULY 2022

Time for a rest!

This newsletter covers the whole month of August, to allow for a bit of a rest for those who communicate our news each week, and recognising that many people across our parishes will be away during this time. I hope that during this month everyone will manage to find some time to slow down, to be refreshed and renewed in mind, body and spirit.

In this season of summer and holidays perhaps this is an important time to focus on an important, but far too frequently forgotten teaching of the Church. The importance of rest.

In the Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Catholic Church there is a section dedicated to 'The dignity of work' and under this a sub-heading 'Rest from work'. This begins:

'Rest from work is a right. As God "rested on the seventh day from all the work which he had done" (*Gen* 2:2), so too men and women, created in his image, are to enjoy sufficient rest and free time that will allow them to tend to their family, cultural, social and religious life.' (284)

Primarily this points to the sanctity of the Sabbath as a day from resting from work, but it is not exclusive of this. We live in a society where work is seen as a central part of our lives – much of our focus each day is on our work – it is seen as something we must do above everything else. But perhaps here we need to look at the origins of the word 'work' itself. In the ancient world work was a form of 'non-leisure'. In Greek, the word for leisure is *schole*, and the word for business, *ascholia*, which is the negative of *schole*. The same is true in Latin. The word for rest or leisure is *otium*. Its negative-*negotium* means business or work.

In this summer season, as things generally get quieter, let us see rest and leisure as a positive thing in our relationship with God and with each other. Let us remember the need to follow the example of God himself, and stop, and spend time looking around us, so that we can truly see what is important and have the energy to follow his will in the years ahead.

Loving Father, during this time of rest and relaxation, please repair in me what is weary or broken and revive my drooping spirit.

Let this holiday be a graced time of recollection and rejuvenation, of deeper self-awareness and eager self-giving.

May it be an occasion of refreshment and reinvigoration – a time to reclaim my friendship with Jesus Christ, who is our Lord now and forever. Amen.

MARCH FOR LIFE SATURDAY 3RD SEPTEMBER 2022

10 million preborn children have legally died through abortion in the UK, leaving behind many deeply hurt women and men. There is no other issue that results in so much loss of life each year as abortion, and the subsequent ripple effects in marriages, relationships, wider families and society are incalculable. Each life lost is precious and that is why the theme for this year's March for Life is '10 million too many'. Mass will be celebrated at 11am at St George's Cathedral, Southwark SE1 7HY by Bishop John Sherrington. There will also be a pro-life family-friendly festival (LifeFest22) at the Emmanuel Centre, Westminster, from 10.30 - 1.30 consisting of; pro-life stalls, talks, children's sessions, entertainment and music, with an opportunity for Confession for anyone who wants this. The march itself sets off at 2pm outside the Emmanuel Centre and ends at 4.30pm in Parliament Square with final speeches.
