New beginnings

Our newsletter returns this week after a summer break and as we return there is lots of news to share. Firstly, this weekend we welcome our new Assistant Priest, Fr Matteo Di Giuseppe to the parishes. This is Fr Matteo's first appointment since his ordination to the priesthood in June and I am sure everyone will give him a warm welcome as he begins his ministry with us. It is a steep learning curve for a newly ordained priest to become accustomed to this role and I know that the support and prayers of our parishes will give Fr Matteo great strength and encouragement in the years ahead.

Fr Damian certainly found this support in our parishes and I would like to thank everyone who was involved in his Mass of thanksgiving for his 5 years serving our parishes on Wednesday evening. It was a wonderful occasion when our three parishes came together to celebrate Mass in the beautiful outdoor setting. Thank you particularly to all those who co-ordinated the set-up, the liturgy and the reception which all flowed so seamlessly. Hopefully, there will be many other joint ventures like this to look forward to in the future.

This is an exciting time for our parishes with lots of things going on and it really does feel like a time of renewal after the challenging years of covid. Over the next few weeks our GIFT family catechesis will be continuing to grow, where our families are growing together in their faith. This term our new youth choir will start to rehearse and over time sing at one Mass a month in Mill End and at Rickmansworth. Our Youth Ministry Leadership Team will also soon be publicising events for our young people over the coming months, for them to continue to be engaged with their faith and to grow within our community.

In these weeks we will also be starting a new season of the Prayer and Life Workshops, where we have the opportunity to grow in our prayer life. We will be starting a new programme of adult formation and our RCIA course will soon begin, welcoming and giving instruction to those who wish to become Catholics.

We will also begin to have day pilgrimages from our parish. The first of these is on Saturday 24th September for our pilgrimage to Walsingham, where we will have the opportunity to join parishes from across the diocese led by Cardinal Vincent Nichols in England's beautiful shrine to Our Lady. This will be followed by a visit to Stevenage in October, to visit the relics of St Bernadette, which begin their tour of the UK this weekend. My hope is that these two pilgrimages will be the start of regular opportunities for us to visit places of interest to our faith over the coming years.

This all of course takes place during a time of economic and social uncertainty. We all know that the next few months are going to be incredibly challenging for many in our community. We hope that over this time the Church will be a source of refuge and strength for all those who are struggling and are vulnerable. Over these next few months please do consider whether you could give time and resources to the initiatives we set up and advertise, so we can indeed show love for our neighbour and support the most vulnerable in our community.

May the Lord continue to bless our parishes and may the witness of our faith continue to shine in Rickmansworth, Mill End and Chorleywood so all may encounter Jesus through us serving others.
