THIRTY FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR C) - 30th OCTOBER 2022

May they rest in peace

November is traditionally the time when we pray for those who have died. In our liturgy we pray during the second Eucharistic Prayer 'remember our brothers and sisters, who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection, and all who have died in your mercy; welcome them into the light of your face'. This is a prayer we echo throughout this month, beginning on Tuesday 1st November when we celebrate those who are already in heaven in the celebration of All Saints Day. This is a holy day of obligation. Throughout November, beginning with the All Souls Day on Wednesday 2nd November, we then pray for the faithful departed who are in purgatory, waiting for the day when they will join the company of the saints in heaven. The Church's need and duty of prayer for the departed souls continues the tradition of our jewish ancestors. In the Old Testament we read: "It is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins" (2 Macc 12: 46). It is also one of the Corporal Acts of Mercy to pray for the dead. Traditionally in this month we like to remember those we have known and loved, but it is also a time when we pray for those who have no-one to pray for them. Over the coming weeks we will have a number of events in the parish which will aid us in our prayers.

Firstly, on Saturday 5th November we will have a Mass for those who have died in our parishes, particularly remembering those who have died over the past year. This is an opportunity for us to pray for deceased members of our community and to support those who mourn their passing. This will be followed by a series of blessings of graves where our priests will be available to say prayers and bless the graves of those who are buried in the area. This year we will also be hosting the annual Deanery Mass for the deceased clergy of the deanery to which all are most welcome.

During the coming month we will also unite with our community in remembering those who have died in war, joining the Armistice Day Act of Remembrance, and the Remembrance Sunday Procession ending with prayers at the War Memorial in St Mary's Churchyard. This is a chance for us to give thanks for those who have given their lives in service, but also to pray for peace in our world, so such a sacrifice does not have to be made again.

Full details of all these events can be found inside this newsletter.

We will of course also have the names of the Holy Souls we wish to be remembered at Mass placed before the Altars in each of our churches throughout this month, and we may remember our loved ones who have died in many other ways.

November is also a month where we should think about our own death and be helping the community to pray for us when that time comes. The Church encourages us to be prepared for the day when our lives are ended, and to support our family and friends by having a plan for our funeral written down. Sheets to help us with this will be available to take away throughout November. SICK & RETIRED PRIESTS' FUND COLLECTION

Next weekend is the annual collection for sick and retired priests in the Diocese of Westminster. There are more than 66 sick and retired priests who receive support after a lifetime of service to their parishes. By 2025 the number of priests in retirement is set to double. Most priests offer their resignation as a parish priest at the age of 75, but many continue to serve in our parishes, schools, hospices, and hospitals. At this time, they are dependent on the Diocese for their care – for essentials like housing, any health needs and other essentials. These priests have baptised us. They have welcomed us, and our families, into the Church. They have counselled us at times of crisis, sat with us through grief and sorrow, and shared in times of joy. They have given to us all and now, in their old age or sickness, they need us to give back. By giving to the Sick & Retired Priests' Fund, you can ensure our priests are cared for. You can take a donation envelope as you leave Church today. Please note that the envelopes and posters also feature a 'QR Code' that you can scan with a phone camera to give online, to make donating more succinct. Please continue to pray for all our clergy: active, retired or ill. Thank you.
