# EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD 9<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2023

# "We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song"

As we celebrate Easter we are called to enter into the joy of the resurrection. The excitement of the women at the tomb. The astonishment of the disciples on hearing the news of the empty tomb. The joy of those in the room when Jesus first appeared, risen and in his glory. In a true sense joy is the message of the Gospel and we are called to share our joy at the news of the resurrection with all those in our lives — with our children, with our parents, with our families and friends, with our work colleagues and those we meet in our everyday lives.

Faith is the source of this joy. As Pope St John Paul II proclaimed 'We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song!'

This Easter let us seek to share our joy with others. Let us pray that we will be parishes that grow together in our encounter with Christ, and that serve those in our community with love and compassion, so that the people of Rickmansworth, Mill End and Chorleywood may come to know the source of our joy and the power of God's saving love for us all.

# NOTICES FOR ALL THREE PARISHES

#### **COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS**

The Bishops of England and Wales have decided that the re-introduction of Holy Communion under both kinds, i.e. under the form of bread and under the form of wine, may take place from the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper 2023. We will be re-introducing this in our parishes for this Mass and the Easter Vigil Mass at first, before hopefully re-introducing it more regularly in the coming months. The reception of Holy Communion under both kinds is not obligatory, as our Catholic faith teaches that the totality of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of the Lord is received in either or both kinds. Therefore, it will be for each person to choose whether she or he wishes to receive Holy Communion from the chalice. Please note that it is not permitted for anyone in the congregation to "intinct" or dip their Host into the chalice when they come to receive Holy Communion. The Precious Blood must be drunk directly from the chalice or Communion received in one kind only.

The offering at the Easter Masses is your personal gift to your priests. The Easter and Christmas offerings, together with the stole fees and Mass stipends form the personal income paid by the parishes to Fr Andrew and Fr Matteo.
