Living the vision

Last week we gave an update on the progress of our GIFT (Growing in Faith Together) process for the families of our parishes, and at this time we are also promoting the new series of Prayer and Life Workshops. This weekend we also have our joint parishes event 'Brass on the Grass' which we hope will be a great event to bring our three communities together. These activities, and many others taking place in our parishes seek to live out our Vision Statement:

The Catholic Parishes of Rickmansworth, Chorleywood and Mill End aspire to share the Good News of God's saving love. We are vibrant, welcoming communities, united in worshipping God and serving our neighbours. We invite every person to join us in growing together in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, experiencing and living through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The purpose of a Vision Statement is for us to constantly be asking ourselves – is this something that we are truly seeking to grow in together? Do we aspire to share the good news of God's saving love? Are we vibrant, welcoming communities? Are we united in our service to God and our neighbours? And are we all trying to grow in our personal relationship with Jesus Christ? The important word in all this is 'grow'. We recognise that none of us are perfect, our parishes aren't perfect – but as Christians, we are all seeking to grow in that perfection – to constantly seek to be more like the people God has made us to be, and the Church God wants us to be.

After two years here in our parishes I have seen many things taking place to suggest we are trying to live out this vision. I thank all those who are playing an active role in our parishes to make this happen. Our JPPC (Joint Parishes Pastoral Council), who meet bi-monthly, try to help us keep focused on this vision, which can so often be blurred by the maintenance and administration needed to run three parishes.

There are two areas in particular that I have come to feel are neglected in our parishes, which we would like to try and address over the coming months, but in order for us to do this we do need people to volunteer their time and gifts to assist us.

Parents and Toddlers Group — Currently we have many families bringing their little children to Mass, but there is nothing else to connect them to the parish. In conversations with St Peter's C of E Church in Mill End, we have both seen there is a need for us to provide a group for them. We would propose a joint project of a weekly Parents and Toddlers Group, based in Mill End. In order for this to happen, we will need volunteers ready to lead this project. Is this something you could help with?

Bereavement Support Group – one of the times that we need support the most is when we lose someone that is close to us. The journey to the funeral can be very busy organising things, and lots of people step forward to support the bereaved, but often, once the service is over, many feel isolated and alone. As a Christian community we should be offering more support to the bereaved, and so we would like to create a group whose main aim is to befriend those in the parish who are grieving, to journey with them, pray for them and support them. This would not be a professional counselling service, but those involved would receive training in journeying with those who are bereaved with compassion and

If you are interested in being involved in either of these groups then please contact the parish office.

I am sure there are many reading this thinking 'but what about doing...'! Yes, there is lots more to be done, and lots more ways that we can serve our parishes and our community. If you are passionate about something and are willing to take the lead in helping us organise it, please do bring it to my attention. We all have a part to play in living out our vision. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit will inspire us to step forward with enthusiasm and joy to answer that call. *Fr Andrew*

CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE

A Certificate of Catholic Practice is exactly what it says - it confirms, for the purposes of a Catholic school application, that families are practising Catholics, i.e. attend Mass every weekend. The school form states that families practice the faith and are known to the priest signing the form. If you do not attend Mass every weekend and are not known to Fr Andrew, he is unfortunately unable to sign the form. If you have recently moved into the area, your previous parish priest can provide certification. If you require a CCP to be signed by Fr Andrew, in the first instance, please see him after Mass

MARY'S MEALS

Mary's Meals would like to invite you to collect all your foreign currency* no matter how old or obscure. After the summer break especially if some of you have travelled abroad, we would like you to put all your foreign coins/notes aside; we will be collecting all your foreign currency in September/October with special Mary's Meals envelopes available at the back of church. DIOCESAN NOTICES

ILLEGAL MIGRATION BILL

Caritas Bakhita House has signed a statement which calls the Illegal Migration Bill cruel, inhumane and unworkable, and a "charter for traffickers". Bishop Paul McAleenan has said "While we all wish to end dangerous Channel crossings, this new legislation treats migrants and refugees as a problem to be solved rather than brothers and sisters towards whom we have responsibilities." This Bill is currently in the "ping-pong" stage, and was sent back to the House of Lords after the Commons rejected most of the amendments they proposed. Caritas Westminster, along with other charities including CAFOD and the Jesuit Refugee Service is asking people to urgently write to their MPs.
