Entrusted with faith

In our Gospel this weekend we hear Jesus exclaim 'I bless you Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for hiding these things from the learned and the clever and revealing them to mere children'. Just over a year ago in our parishes we launched our Growing in Faith Together (GIFT) Family Catechesis, seeking to journey with our families in a new way to help support parents to reveal our faith to their children, but in the process to help them rediscover or discover it for themselves.

This family catechesis has been available in two ways. Firstly, in a monthly Saturday Family Session, when our families come together for a special Mass, enjoy a time of fellowship before sharing catechesis and activities based on different topics such as the Saints, Epiphany, Lent, Holy Week. We also have an opportunity each month for our parents to meet one evening online to explore their own faith and to enable them to them to live out their calling to pass that faith onto their children. This process is both flexible around the busy lives all our families have, but also practical, in a set-up where we have three parishes to run and a limited number of resources. A year into this process, we currently have 42 families signed up for GIFT, many of whom are participating regularly in the sessions, getting to know not only their faith but their parish community better. GIFT is for all our families with children in primary school and it is an excellent opportunity for all of us to grow in our faith together. In recent feedback one parent wrote: 'We enjoy the classes a lot. Pitched well for the children across the age groups and as a parent I really enjoy learning at the same time as my child, as well as broadening my Catholic community meeting other parents and their children'.

Participation in GIFT is also a gateway for those who feel their children are ready to begin their preparation for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Engaging with GIFT, alongside coming to Mass each week, gives us an opportunity to discern together the right time for the child to receive these important sacraments. The material for the preparation is then parent-led at home at the pace of the child, with the guidance of one of our catechist mentors. Again, this is more flexible than the traditional classes, and works around the child's readiness for the Sacraments rather than to a particular timetable. So far in the past year, 9 children have received their First Holy Communion in our parishes at their usual Sunday Parish Mass, but there are currently 15 others who are preparing for the Sacraments, and over the coming months others will also enter into this journey when they are ready to do so.

We thank those who have helped us take this bold but necessary step in our parishes and particularly those families who have been pioneers on this journey. We continue to pray that GIFT will give all our families encouragement and strength in journeying together in faith. If you do not attend Mass every weekend and are not known to Fr Andrew, he is unfortunately unable to sign the form.
