## TWENTY FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR A) - 17<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2023

## **A Pilgrim Church**

We conclude our first part of our Vatican 2 series looking at the Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, Lumen Gentium.

Chapter six of Lumen Gentium offers an explanation of the Church's understanding of the call to Religious life. This is the vocation of those, who, for the sake of witnessing to the reality and absolute supremacy of the Kingdom of God, and in an effort to live out the Lord's call to strive for Christian perfection, leave all worldly comforts and earthly pursuits behind, and embrace the evangelical counsels of holy poverty, chastity for the Kingdom of heaven, and obedience. Those persons called to embrace a vocation to the religious life strip themselves of everything that is not conducive to living a radically Christ-centred lifestyle, in imitation of our Lord, who proposed this way of life to those who could accept it. A vocation to the religious state of life, from the vantage point of the hierarchy, should not be thought of as a state of life that is "in between" the lay state and the clerical state. Rather, individuals from both of these states-lay and clerical alike-may assume the religious vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. Thus, many male religious societies are comprised of both non-ordained and ordained brothers alike. The same, however, cannot be said of women's religious societies, as women are not permitted to be ordained deacons, priests, or bishops within the Catholic Church; all women religious are necessarily, non-ordained sisters (LG 43-47).

Chapter Seven focuses on the topic of the eschatological nature of the pilgrim Church on earth, and our profound union with the Church in heaven. Section 48 begins: "The Church, to which we are all called in Christ Jesus, and in which we acquire sanctity through the grace of God, will attain her full perfection only in the glory of heaven, when there will come the time of the restoration of all things. At that time, the human race as well as the entire world, which is intimately related to man and attains to its end through him, will be perfectly re-established in Christ". The document here talks of our union with those who have died, both praying for those who have died so they may be freed from their sins, but also praying for the intercession of the saints, who as witnesses and model of holiness have entered heaven, and are joined with us in Christ. Lastly, Section 50 explains that it is precisely through participation in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass that the Pilgrim Church on earth, or the Church Militant, is most closely and perfectly united with the Heavenly Court, the Church Triumphant. (LG 48-51).

The final chapter of Lumen Gentium is dedicated to the role of 'Our Lady', the Blessed Virgin Mary in the life of the Church. The document affirms Mary's unique place in salvation history as the Mother of God and emphasizes her cooperation in the redemptive work of Christ, but also states that this is not the place for a complete doctrine on Mary. It goes onto describe the role of Mary in the Economy of Salvation, stating that from the account of her Annunciation 'the holy Fathers see her as used by God not merely in a passive way, but as freely cooperating in the work of human salvation through faith and obedience'. The document continues by looking at Mary's role in the Church pointing to her as a model of faith to which the 'Church, in her apostolic work also, justly looks to her, who, conceived of the Holy Spirit, brought forth Christ, who was born of the Virgin that through the Church He may be born and may increase in the hearts of the faithful also.' The chapter on the Mary continues by looking at the cult of the Blessed Virgin, emphasising that devotion to Our Lady has existed throughout the history of the Church and is encouraged, but such devotion must 'always look to Christ, as the source of all truth, sanctity and piety.' The document concludes by pointing to Mary as a sign of hope and solace to the wandering people of God as we look to be happily gathered together in peace and harmony into one people of God, for the glory the Most Holy and Undivided Trinity.

#### **CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE**

A Certificate of Catholic Practice is exactly what it says - it confirms, for the purposes of a Catholic school application, that families are practising Catholics, i.e. attend Mass every weekend. The school form states that families practice the faith and are known to the priest signing the form. If you do not attend Mass every weekend and are not known to Fr Andrew, he is unfortunately unable to sign the form. If you have recently moved into the area, your previous parish priest can provide certification. If you require a CCP to be signed by Fr Andrew, in the first instance, please see him after Mass.

### PARENTS AND TODDLERS GROUP

Working with St Peter's C of E Church in Mill End, we are looking to set up a parents and toddlers group together. This would be a weekly group based in Mill End. In order for this to begin, we need volunteers ready to lead the project. Is this something you could help with? Please contact the parish office if it is.

#### BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP

One of the times that we need support the most is when we lose someone that is close to us. The journey to the funeral can be very busy organising things, and lots of people step forward to support the bereaved, but often, once the service is over, many feel isolated and alone. As a Christian community we should be offering more support to the bereaved, and so we would like to create a group whose main aim is to befriend those in the parish who are grieving, to journey with them, pray for them and support them. This would not be a professional counselling service, but those involved would receive training in journeying with those who are bereaved with compassion and care. #### **GROWING IN FAITH TOGETHER (GIFT)**

Our family catechesis for all those with children aged 5-11 takes place once a month. The sessions are engaging, spiritfilled and fun, and they are for all the family. We celebrate Mass, enjoy a time of fellowship and refreshment before sharing catechesis and activities on a different theme each month.
