Deep listening / intentional speaking (St John the Evangelist Church Hall, Mill End)

Have you ever had those surprising conversations which go deeper, end up at unexpected destinations and leave you enriched in some way? How might we be more intentional about these kinds of conversations as we find ourselves alongside side others? Together, we will unpack some of the features of this way of accompaniment that is part of being Church.

Discernment (Our Lady Help of Christians Church Hall, Rickmansworth and on Zoom)

How can we know if something comes from the Holy Spirit? Discernment is a key part of our life of faith. Focusing on Ignatian tradition of Discernment of Spirits, we consider what discernment is and how we might further grow in using it in our everyday life.
