First Holy Communion It is our joy this weekend and for the following two Sundays to rejoice with the young people and their families celebrating their first Holy Communion. Please keep them in your prayers. There may be more people than usual at the 10:30am Masses, you may wish to consider coming to one of the other weekend masses to create more space for our guests.

Children's liturgy starts again on 22nd May. This will take place during the 10:30am Mass on Sundays, during term-time. Children's liturgy is for our youngest parishioners, so that they can hear the Word of God

proclaimed in a language more appropriate to their levels of understanding. It is aimed at children from birth through to Year 3 at school (when they typically make their First Holy Communion) - if your child is below nursery age and comes along, they will need someone with them. The liturgy usually includes singing, learning about the Gospel, prayer, and some sort of activity—often to do with marker pens. We are looking forward to seeing you at the Children's Liturgy, and we thank you for your continued prayers for this ministry and the children of our parish.

Fire Wardens One of the things we need to do as we return to greater normality is refresh our Fire Warden rotas. Not least some of those who were acting as Fire Wardens have moved (including one to Singapore!) There will be a training session for Fire Wardens at 7:30pm on Wednesday 4th May in the sacristy. This is both as a reminder and update for those who have previously been Fire Wardens and an invitation for new volunteers. The role is important but not arduous – *we hope we never have a fire in Church which will need wardens* - but we do need people willing to follow some simple procedures on how to respond to the unlikely scenario and we must have two fire wardens at each mass. If you can help please sign up on the list in the sacristy and come along on Wednesday.

The **Christian Leadership Formation programme** is running for a second consecutive year and is currently open to applications from students in Lower Sixth. The application deadline is Friday 3rd June 2022. The programme is for students who are actively committed to their faith, who are intellectually gifted and who are committed to shaping a Christian society through their careers. It provided a spiritual and philosophical/theological formation in the Catholic tradition around themes relating to the common good, as well as workshops in skills pertaining to public life. Part- to full sponsorships are available to students who are unable to meet the costs, though we students are asked to attempt to fundraise £140 (10% of the course's costs) as a minimum contribution. Priest Training Fund The annual collection for the Priest Training Fund will take place **next weekend**. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 58 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 17 of whom are from our own Diocese, and two men are studying in Rome, also from our Diocese. Last year four men who studied at Allen Hall were ordained to the priesthood to serve as our future priests. This fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests.
